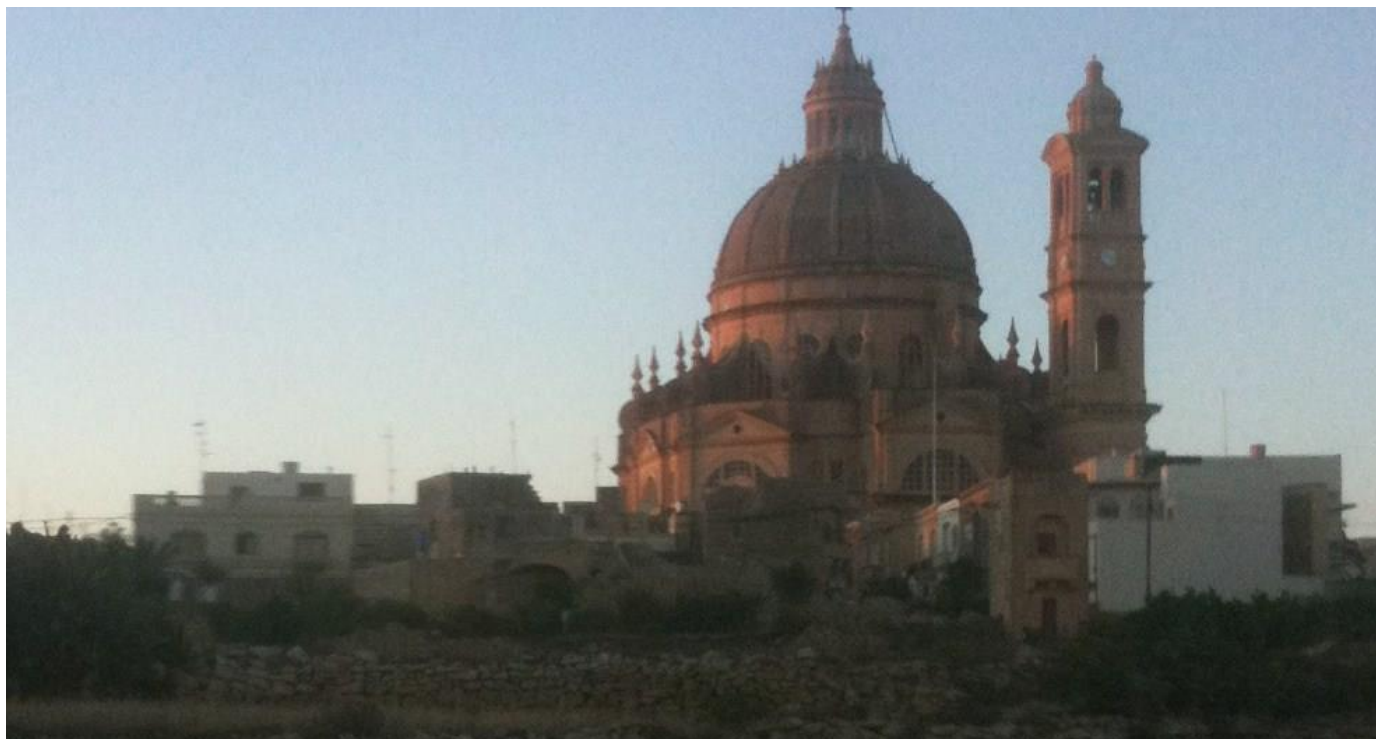


VIVA World Cup 2010™ in the island of Calypso.

VIVA World Cup 2010™ in the island Gozo therefore hosted the fourth edition of the VIVA World Cup™. The island of Calypso goddess whose FA is affiliated with the Malta FA, then saw his selection to evolve on its land for the first time at international level. In a beautiful setting with so monumental that village churches, this paradise prickly therefore welcomed the split again into 2 groups of 3 teams competition. Classic pattern with ½ final cross match and ranking the second round and the final ranking to finish.



A new arrival in the family: the FA of the Kingdom of 2 Sicilies (historical part of Southern Italy and Sicily), which promised a bright and catchy selection. The match between Padania and K. 2 Sicilies was uncertain until the end and impassioned media. The other semi final was equally hung between Kurdistan and Occitania. This is very controversial way Padania pocketed his third title in a row in front of a great team of Kurdistan in the opinion and the cameras have equalized (but refused to position an offside player yet from the rear). Mistake is human and Kurdistan always classy and fair play.

Always very satisfactory balance with 31 goals in 11 matches (2.81 goals per game), although lighter than previous editions.



Parallel to the men's tournament, the island of the goddess was the ideal setting for the launch of the VIVA World Cup™ WOMEN. The tournament will be between the teams of Gozo and Padania, in 2 matches with the coronation of Padania ultimately. With a record of 7 goals in 2 matches, all marked by the Padanian team.



Less than $\frac{1}{2}$ hour of Malta, the tournament was held on the island of Gozo which seems light years away from many as there are different mentalities. Would recommend for tourism as everything seems cut off from the world. The quality of its hotel infrastructure and local food again did the 3rd Halftime was celebrated late into the night, and well watered.
